Ross Fountain and Edinburgh Castle, Edinburgh

This fountain in Princes Street Gardens is an exquisite piece of Victorian cast-iron craftsmanship, reflecting classical themes, and featuring cherubs, water nymphs and mermaids, gifted to the city in 1872 by Daniel Ross. Edinburgh Castle, perched on the volcanic Castle Rock, dominates the city skyline.

Caledonian Canal, Fort Augustus, Highland

Built by Thomas Telford to link the east and west of Scotland and opened in 1822, the 100km-long Caledonian Canal includes four sea lochs along the Great Glen. Fort Augustus is a pretty village where the canal joins Loch Ness. Boats pass through and negotiate the impressive canal lock staircase.

The Quiraing, Isle of Skye

The Quiraing is a long ridge of vertical cliffs, jagged rock pinnacles and pillars forming a bizarre landscape above scenic Staffin Bay on Skye's Trotternish Peninsula. The formations include a 36m-high stack called the Needle; a hidden high plateau - the Table; and a pyramid-shaped crag - the Prison.

Glenfinnan Viaduct, Highland

This iconic 21-arch viaduct, on the West Highland Railway (seen in the *Harry Potter* films), curves across the glen, through a landscape of high peaks, pine forests, moors and rivers. At the head of Loch Shiel, the Glenfinnan Monument, - a 20m pillar, - commemorates Bonnie Prince Charlie's arrival in 1745.

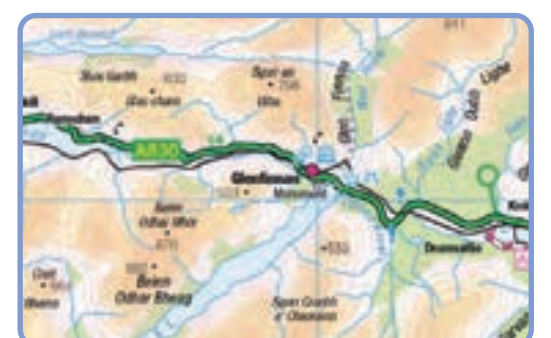

Sanna Bay, Highland

This stunning beach of pristine white shell sand, divided by rocky outcrops, backed by dunes and machair, is located on the isolated and rugged Ardnamurchan Peninsula, with superb views of the Small Isles of Coll, Eigg and Rum. Ardnamurchan Point is the westernmost place on the British mainland.

Culzean Castle, South Ayrshire

Set on a clifftop overlooking the Firth of Clyde, Culzean Castle stands in a large country park amid extensive gardens, woodland and beaches. It was redesigned as a country retreat for the Marquis of Ailsa by Robert Adam in the 18th century, with elegant rooms and an exquisite Georgian interior.

Old Man of Hoy, Orkney

This extraordinary 137m-layered red sandstone sea stack stands aloof from the cliffs on an old lava flow, which shelters it from erosion from the power of wind and waves. Hoy is the second largest of the Orkneys, with a rugged landscape, glacial valleys, arctic-alpine flora and towering sea cliffs.

Linn of Dee, Braemar, Highland

At this picturesque spot, the River Dee passes through a narrow chasm, creating fast currents and waterfalls. The tiered rocks and banks, either side of the churning gorge, are lined with rowan, birch, fir and pine trees. The ornate Gothic-style castellated bridge was opened by Queen Victoria in 1857.

Loch Leven, Perthshire

This is Scotland's largest lowland loch, nestling beneath the Lomond Hills. The tiny islands and reedy shoreline are a habitat for tufted ducks, pink-footed geese, otters and sea eagles. The ruined 14th-century castle on Castle Island was where Mary Queen of Scots was imprisoned (1567-68).

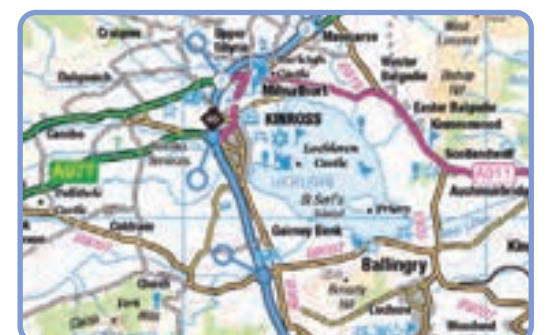
